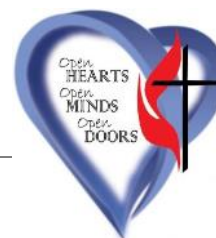

## Church Safety

Our prayers are with the families and people affected by the Burnette Chapel Church of Christ and Sutherland Springs Baptist Church shootings. Lord, hear our prayers for peace and love in our fallen world.

The following information is meant to be informative. We will continue to be welcoming to those who enter our church but we must also be smart about any situation which could be potentially dangerous.

With the increase in violence at churches we all must remain vigilant in our efforts to keep each other safe. Remember to keep all doors locked when you are in the building. If the door is to remain open until everyone arrives, please post a person with a cell phone in case of an emergency at the door until it is time to lock the door for the meeting. After locking the door post a sign for late comers with a number to call or text to gain entry.

One of the most important things to remember is if you see something suspicious say something. **Always call 911** when you feel a person or situation is threatening. If you are in the building, and feel threatened leave the building immediately. If you are unable to exit go to a secure location and lock or barricade yourself inside. Do not come out until the police have arrived and the 911 operator tells you it is safe to do so. Do not hang up on a 911 call because that slows down the dispatch of police assistance.

3 rules given by the Metro Police Department in the event of a threat are:

A...avoid (Escape, flee the scene)

D...deny (Deny access to the intruder by hiding in a locked room or barricaded room.)

D...defend (Last resort is to use whatever resources available to defend yourself and others such as fire extinguishers, heavy objects, etc.)

More safety tips will follow.
